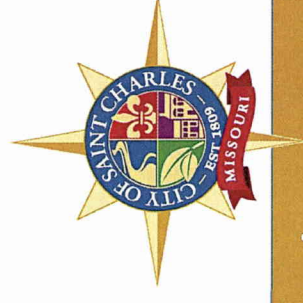

Character of West Clark

- Low Volume – Average Daily Traffic of 761 vehicles per day
- Narrow Width – 19’-21’ asphalt driving surface
- Close Garages and Pedestrian Traffic
- Posted Speed Limit of 25 mph
- Average Observed Speed of 21 mph
- Corridor does not meet traffic calming eligibility requirements
