Concrete Maintenance Projects

The 2022 Concrete Repair Project contract is with Amcon Municipal Concrete in the amount of \$1,770,000.00. Concrete slab replacement is currently ongoing in Wards 3, 4, 5, 6, & 8.

The 2022 Concrete Crack Seal Project with Sweetens Concrete Services in the amount of \$182,000.00 is complete in Wards 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, & 7.

The 2022 Sidewalk Pressure Grouting Project with Lift-Rite in the amount of \$135,351.00 is complete in Wards 3, 4, & 5.

Asphalt Maintenance Projects

The 2022 Asphalt Mill & Overlay Project with E. Meier Contracting in the amount of \$1,255,891.00 is complete on Droste Rd., and on streets in Wards 4, 5, 6, 9, & 10.

The 2022 Asphalt Microsurfacing Project with Donelson Construction in the amount of \$338,881.62 is complete in Wards 2, 5, 7, & 10.

The 2022 Asphalt Rejuvenator Project with Corrective Asphalt Materials in the amount of \$37,080.00 is complete on Country Club Rd. in Ward 6, and Droste Rd. adjacent to Wards 9 & 10.
