

SHARED USE PATH MO370 DISCOVERY BRIDGE



Project Overview

This project will install a 42” barrier separated, bicycle & pedestrian path on the westbound 370 bridge. This barrier will protect bicyclists and pedestrians crossing from Saint Charles to St. Louis County. Today, there is signage on the 370 bridge, but bicyclists and pedestrians are not shielded from high-speed traffic. This makes crossing the bridge uncomfortable for pedestrians and bicyclists.

When complete, the project will connect the Katy Trail on the Saint Charles side of the river to the Riverwoods Trail in Bridgeton.
