



PRESERVATION AWARDS

Each year the City of Saint Charles Landmarks Preservation Board honors projects and people that have made outstanding contributions to the preservation of the City's historic character. The 2020-2021 awards will recognize individuals and groups for projects completed between January-December, 2020. The awards ceremony will be held in May 2021, during National Historic Preservation Month.

7 project categories are eligible for Preservation Awards:

Residential, Commercial, Publicly-Owned, Institutionally Owned, Outside Beautification,
Sensitive New In-fill and Personal Achievement

The award-winning projects will be selected based on the following:

- The historical and architectural significance for the property preserved by the project
- Sensitivity to the historic integrity of the building and its site; including streetscapes
- Preservation or replication of historic materials and quality of project craftsmanship
- Impact of the project on the preservation of the town's historic fabric, neighborhoods and resources
- The degree of difficulty of the project

**The project will also be evaluated using the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation.*
